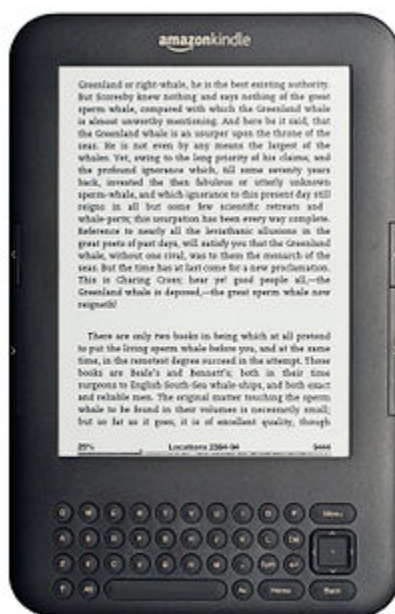

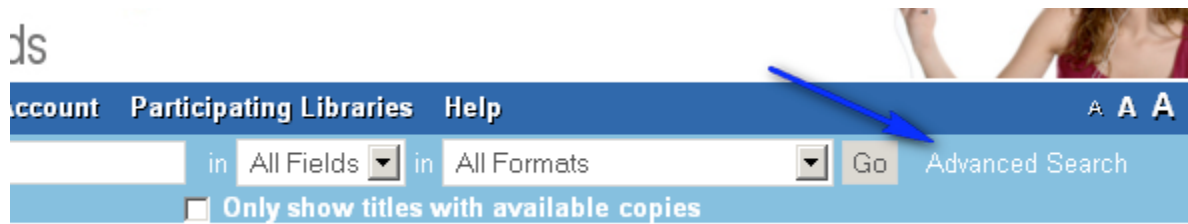

If you have more than one Kindle registered to your amazon.com account then make sure the eBook is delivered to the correct device. Click on ‘Get Library Book’ and make sure it is set to go onto your Kindle.
