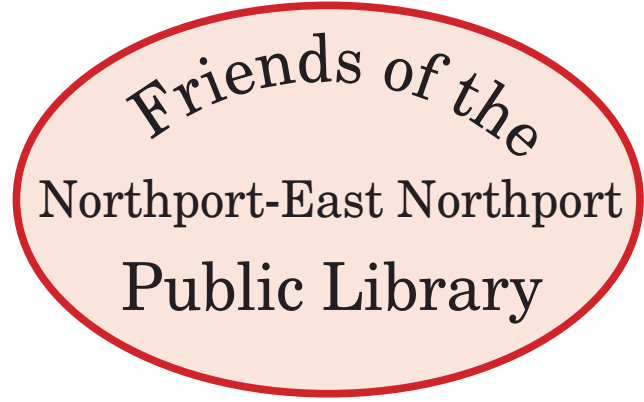
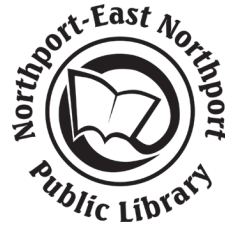

Four-Star Library

In 2009 and again in 2010, *Library Journal* announced its annual national library ratings. It ranked the Northport-East Northport Public Library among the top 3.5% of the nation's public libraries with *LJ Index* scores, and named it a "four-star library" among "America's Star Libraries." The "four-star library" rating is based on four representative service standards—circulation, patron visits, program attendance, and public Internet usage. The Northport-East Northport Public Library is honored to receive this national recognition from *Library Journal*, the oldest and most respected publication covering the library field.
