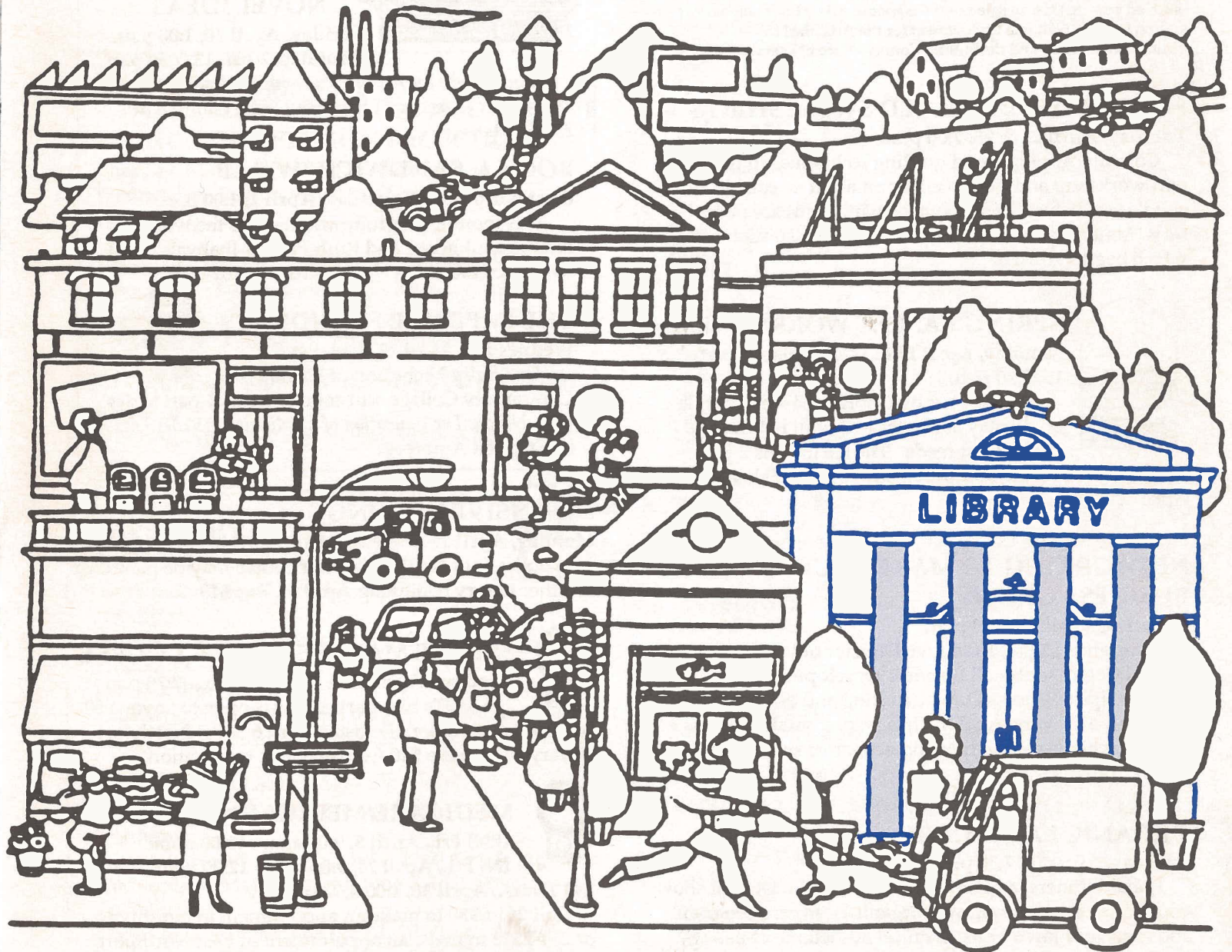

3. You have been a resident of the Northport-East Northport School District for at least 30 days.
4. You are registered to vote. (You are registered if you have voted within the last four years, in a general, school or library election.)

NOTE: Additional parking is available across the street in the Northport Middle School parking lot.

Disabled voters: there is an entrance on the North side of the building.

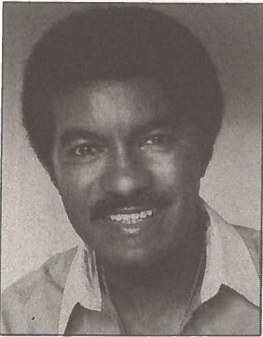

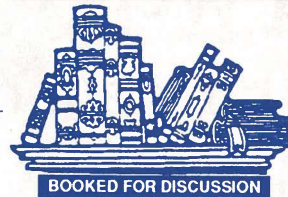


LONG ISLAND COMPOSERS ALLIANCE

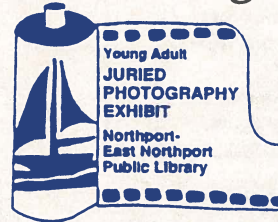

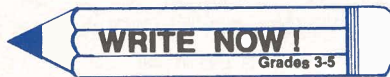

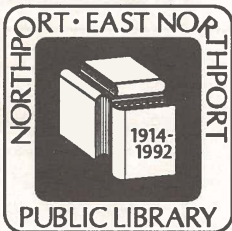
