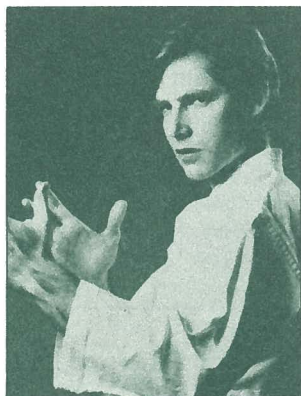

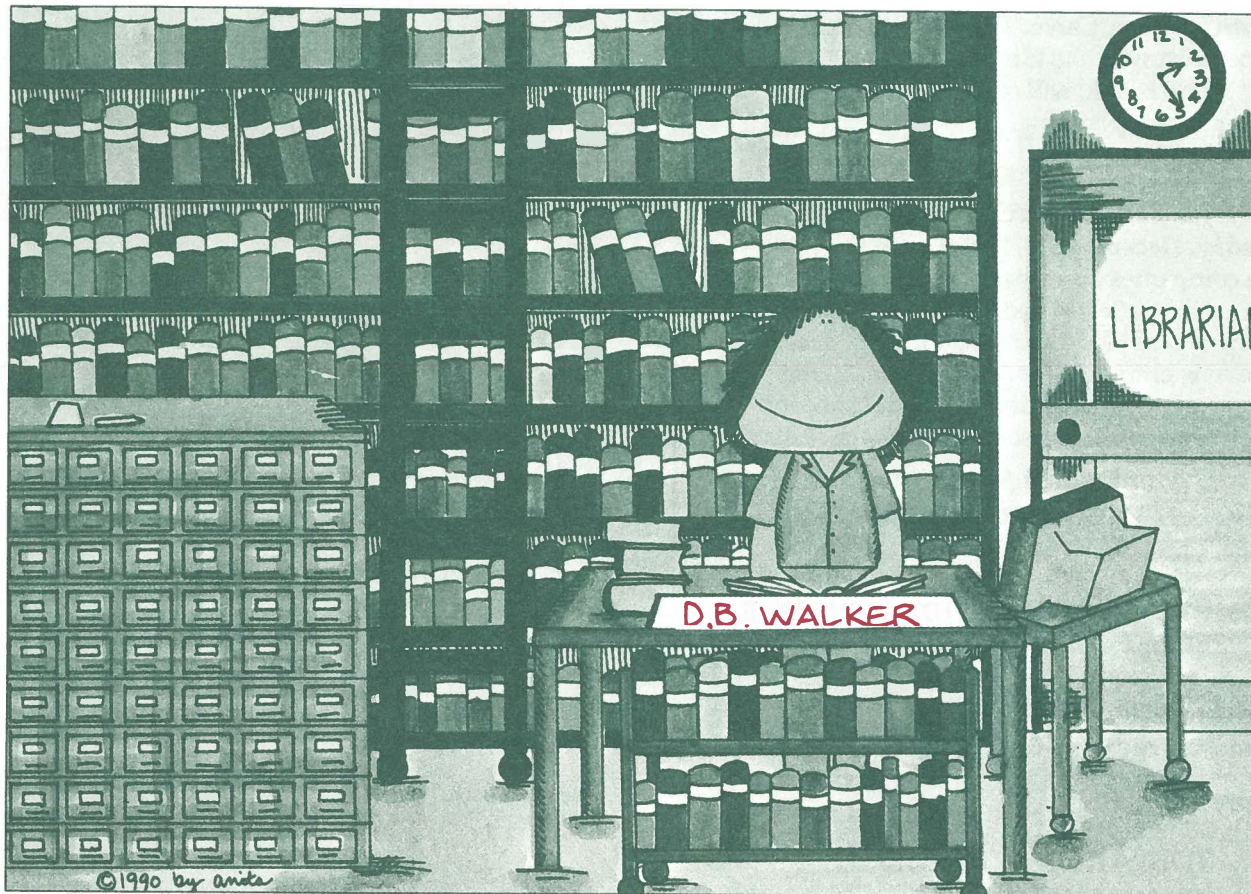

Heard Any Good Books Lately?

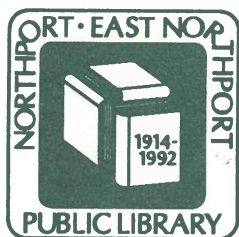
