Tuesday, February 2, 7:30 p.m.

Long Island Childbirth Alternatives, a non-profit consumer organization, will present a slide show that looks at the childbirth experiences of five women. ## JAZZ PIANIST JUNIOR MANCE

Friday, February 5, 8:30 p.m.

Junior Mance, who has worked as a professional musician since age 13, recorded his first album in 1947 with the Gene Ammons band. While serving in the army in 1951, he played in the 36th Army band with Cannonball Adderley. Later, he performed with such jazz greats as Charlie Parker and Dizzie Gillespie, and eventually formed the Junior Mance Trio in 1961. Mance has recorded for the Atlantic Capital and Jazzland labels.

This performance, which is cosponsored by International Art of Jazz, is funded by NEA, NYSCA, and the Suffolk Office of Cultural Affairs. Ticket sales began Jan. 23. Tickets are \$1.00 for adults, 50¢ for students, senior citizens, and handicapped persons.

## NAZIS ON LONG ISLAND: CAMP SIEGFRIED IN THE 1930's

Tuesday, February 23, 7:30 p.m.

Fifty years ago, a Nazi flag and an American flag flew side by side at Camp Siegfried on the shore of Upper Yaphank Lake in the Town of Brookhaven. From its opening in 1935 until its close at the time of America's entry into World War II, Camp Siegfried was a favorite recreation center for German-American families living in the New York City area. It was also a focal point of the Nazi movement in this country. Marvin D. Miller, author of *Wunderlich's Salute*, the story of Camp Siegfried, will explore this period in Long Island's history.

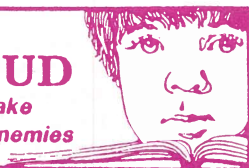
