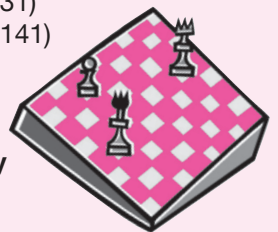

## Sushi Candy Workshop

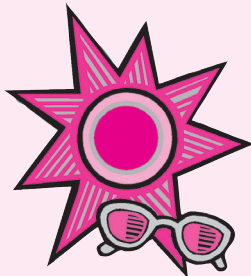
(N) Thursday, July 1, 3:30-5:00 p.m.
