Literally: what does he/she call him/herself?

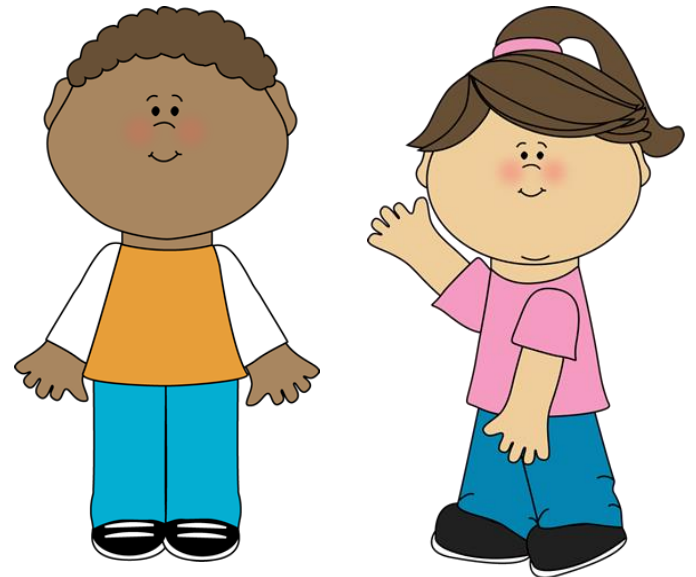
