7) DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Director's Report was given orally. In addition to the packet mailed in advance the report contained the following library service area highlights:

Accounting – Department teamwork prevails with the redistribution of job responsibilities related to the counting of money among the existing staff.

Administrative Assistant – An effectively conducted budget vote resulted in a successful vote with an even stronger than usual ratio (6-1) of Yes to No votes.

Adult Services – Our First Adult Winter Reading Club concluded with 52 members submitting 312 reviews. The winner of the Grand Prize, two donated Engemann theatre tickets, was Ed Nostrand.

Buildings & Grounds – The unscheduled Suffolk County Department of Health's inspection of the East Northport Café resulted in three "blue maintenance" items which were promptly addressed by our Department Head.

Circulation – EN – Staff attended the INN Reach training to prepare for the bridging of Nassau and Suffolk libraries to create a shared Island-wide book collection.

Circulation – NPT – Analysis and evaluation of the cost-saving trial of "picking up" versus "mailing" new library cards showed little savings at the expense of patron convenience; mailing cards has been resumed.

Community Services – The harmonica concert "From Bach to Gershwin" received onsite NEWSDAY coverage with a video posted online, and more than 90 patrons. The performer, in turn, raved about all the work the library staff did to make his performance a success.

Administration – Hosting of the 2 day PLA Virtual Conference for staff to attend was arranged, as well as the webinar "Using the Zappos Experience to Create an Engaging and Inspiring Workplace Culture" for Department Heads.

Three sessions of the Spring EAP Workshop on "Optimism" was appreciatively received by 76 staff members.

East Northport – The Friends-hosted Carnivorous Plant program drew 70 patrons. Many of the attendees were students whose science teacher saw the program in our newsletter and encouraged attendance; the teacher noted that the East Northport bike-friendly location made the strong attendance possible.

Local History – Spencer Rumsey, author of a Jack Kerouac retrospective published in the March 7 edition of THE LONG ISLAND PRESS, credited our library's archives for his research.

Network & Systems – A new wireless Internet system was deployed simplifying access for patrons and enabling the capture of usage reports for this growing service.

Youth Services – Our Department Head was joined by four of her librarians who contributed as planners and presenters at the NYLA Youth Services Section Conference held on Long Island this year. Their topics included programming, book discussion, and school and public library cooperation.

Mrs. Nancy Morcerf, proposed Assistant Director of the Northport-East Northport Library, attended the meeting.
